



English

This term we will be reading 'The Everywhere Bear', 'Augustus and his Smile', 'The Girl with the Parrot on her Head' and 'Biscuit Bear'.

Year One children will be using these texts as a basis for their own writing including designing posters, writing lists and creating character descriptions. Reception children will use Literacy time to embed their Phonic knowledge and play Phonic based games to consolidate their learning.

PSHE

Our PSHE theme for this term is 'Self-Regulation: My Feelings'. In these lessons, we will be practicing our listening and speaking skills as part of our group discussions. We will be reflecting on our feelings as we settle into our new classroom environment.



Music

Our Music topic this term is 'Exploring Sound'. We will be thinking about how we can use our voices and bodies to make a variety of different sounds.



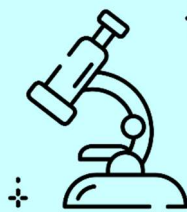
Art

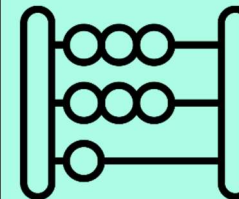

Reception

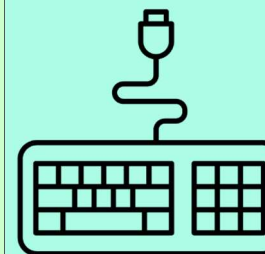
After completing the Baseline Assessment, Reception children will be matching and sorting objects and numbers. They will be comparing amounts as well as size in terms of mass and capacity.
