Autumn 1

Topic: Romans

Maths: White Rose 'small steps' Autumn 1 includes:

Year 3

3 digit numbers, their place value and how they can be partitioned. Locating, comparing and ordering numbers to 1000. Adding and subtracting two and three digit numbers which cross a 10 and 100.

Year 4

Understanding and representing numbers to 10 000, including rounding. Addition and Subtraction with four digit numbers.

English

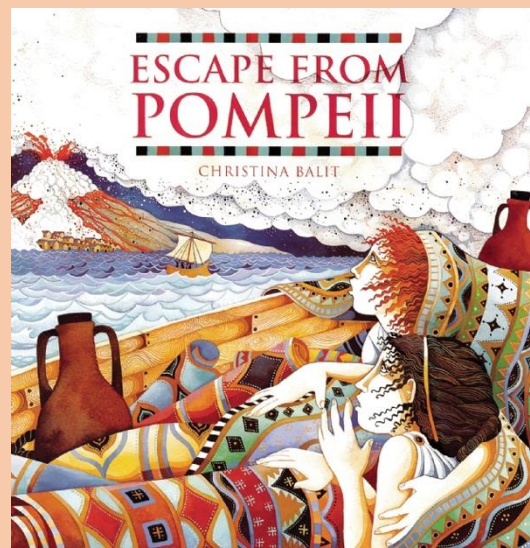
Our focus text for Autumn 1 is Escape from Pompeii by Christina Balit, linked to our history topic Romans.

We will be looking at different writing outcomes over the term including character and setting descriptions, diary entries, poetry and more.

In WCR, we will be looking at how using our reading Vipers can help us understand a text.

Art

We are going to be studying painting and mixed media, focusing on how and why our prehistoric ancestors made art. Like them, we will making homemade paints with natural materials.



History

This term, we are going to be thinking about how life in Britain changed under Roman influence. We will also be investigating how and why the Romans invaded, and chose to settle in Britain.

Science

In Science, we will be exploring scientific ideas, planning and carrying out experiments to understand animals, including humans. We will explore food groups, including nutritional value. We will also explore skeleton types, including human skeletons. During this unit, we will continue to develop our scientific enquiry skills.

French

By the end of the unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to be able to introduce themselves, say how they feel and have a wider appreciation for the country/countries where French is spoken.

PSHE:

Families and relationships: We will be covering the following topics: respect and manners; healthy friendships; behaviour; bullying; stereotypes including gender and disability; families and change and loss.

Music

Ballads: What are they and how do we recognise them? will also explore how different emotions can be conveyed when performing.

R.E:

What do Hindus believe God is like?

We will learn about the concepts of Brahman using stories and by examining some Hindu texts. This will build understanding as to how Hindu's see the world.

P.E:

We will be developing the individual skills and techniques needed for Tag Rugby. Then applying them to to help us become great team players.
