Key Facts

Where did our grandparents go on holiday?	- the beach / Seaside - to see / ride on donkeys

What can souvenirs tell us about holidays in the past?	- where people went - how they got there - what there is there to see & do - so they can remember their holiday
How else can we find out about the recent past?	- books - story books
