Florence Nightingale Born in 1820. A nurse. Made lots of changes to hospitals.

- Healthy food
- Training school
- Clean environment

- Nurses not able to help

Hospitals after

- Clean
- More medicine
- Healthy food

Edith Cavell

- A nurse during World War 1
- Helped soldiers from both sides
