This term we will be reading 'The Snail and the Whale', 'The Way Back Home' and 'The Boy Who Sailed the World'.

Year One children will be using these texts as a basis for their own writing including setting descriptions, character descriptions and diary entries. Reception children will use Literacy time to embed their Phonic knowledge, practice early writing skills and handwriting.

PSHE

Our PSHE theme for this term is 'Managing Self: Taking on Challenges'. In these lessons, we will be practicing our listening and speaking skills as part of our group discussions. We will be reflecting on the importance of rules to keep us safe and working together as a team.

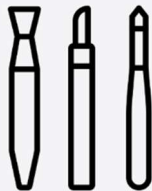


Music

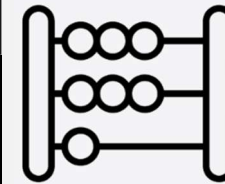
Mathematics

Reception

This term, Reception children will be introduced to the concept of zero in 'Alive in Five', explore 'Mass and Capacity' and the numbers 6, 7 and 8 in 'Growing 6, 7, 8'.



Year 1



Year One children will be focusing on Place Value to 20, including the use of number lines to compare numbers. They will also be exploring Addition and Subtraction within 20, building on their learning from the Autumn term.
