

WHAT ARE THE WONDERS OF THE WORLD AND WHERE ARE THEY?



Geography

We will be learning about what 'World Wonders' are and where they can be found around the world. We will focus on mountains, rivers, ancient world wonders and new world wonders. We'll also learn about our very own 'wonder' in Woodchester - the Woodchester Roman mosaic.

Science

In science this term, we will learn about animals. We'll learn about the five animal groups and begin to explain the characteristics of these groups.

We will also explore whether animals are omnivores, carnivores or herbivores.

English

In English we'll be reading 'How to Find Gold' and focusing on non-fiction texts.

We will:

- Write a setting description
- Create our own adverts
- Write dialogue for characters
- Write a non-chronological report about world wonders

In our whole class reading sessions, we will be reading both fiction and non-fiction books, along with some poetry. We will widen our vocabulary and focus on developing our predicting, sequencing, inferencing and retrieval skills.

Music - Musical Me - exploring pitch using the song, "Once a man fell into a well". We will play tuned percussion instruments and read simple symbols.

Maths

Year 1

Addition and subtraction within 20

- Add by counting on and using number bonds
- Doubles and near doubles
- Subtraction using number bonds, by counting back and by finding the difference

Place value within 50

- Count up to 50 and group tens and ones
- Partition numbers into tens and ones

Year 2

Money

- Count money in pounds and pence
- Make the same amount
- Compare amounts of money and find change

Multiplication and division:

- Make arrays
- Make equal groups - grouping and sharing
- Learn the 2x, 5x and 10x tables

Art

We'll look at sculpture and work with clay. We'll learn about impressing and joining techniques. We will then use our skills to plan and create our own 3D models out of clay.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will learn about how to stay safe. We'll think about how to stay safe on the internet, on and near roads and with medicines.

PE

We will be focusing on dance this term. We will learn to perform dances using simple movement patterns.

Computing - Introduction to Data

Learning what data is, why it is useful and the different ways that it can be gathered and recorded.

RE

We will learn about Christians' belief about God's creation of the universe and that the Earth and everything in it are important to God.
