Year 4 will investigate mixed numbers and proper fractions in greater depth. We will then develop our understanding of fractions link to decimals.

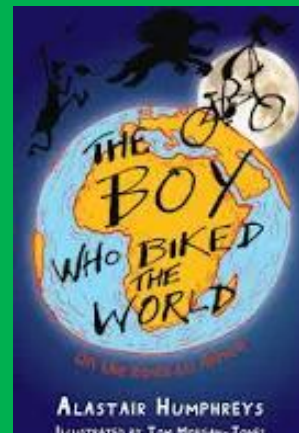
English:
