

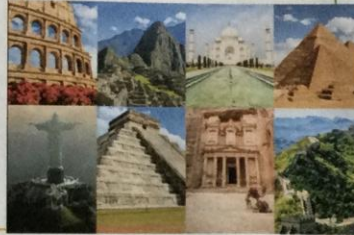
What is a world wonder and where can they be found?

Vocabulary

Wonder	Something amazing. A one off!
Continent	A massive area of land, usually separated by oceans.
Ocean	A vast, continuous body of salt water.
Mountain	A giant piece of land that sticks way up high.
River	A large amount of water.
Desert	A large area of land. Lack of animals/plants.
Ancient	Something extremely old - that has existed for a long time.
Modern	Something that is happening today or in the recent past.

Key Facts

Mount Everest Highest mountain in the world. Cold. Avalanches. Steep

River Nile Longest river in the world. Flooded in Africa.

Christ the Redeemer Found in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. A statue that is 30 metres tall.

Great Wall of China The longest structure ever built by humans. It is 6300km long

The River Severn The longest river in the UK - starts in Wales and ends in England. It is 220 miles long.

London The biggest city + the capital of the UK. Has a population of 8.7 million people.
