Summer 1 - Beech



Geography

This term we will be learning about different animals from around the world. We'll find out about their habitats and describe the landscapes that they live in.

Art

We will be making 3D maps using different craft techniques and we will be thinking of how to present our artwork.

PE

We will be swimming this term at Stratford Park. We will also use our Forest School sessions to practise our fine and gross motor skills.

English

In English we'll be reading "The Lonely Beast".

We will:

- Write diary entries
- Write poetry
- Write a newspaper report
- Write a quest story

In our whole class reading sessions, we will be reading both fiction and non-fiction books, along with some poetry. We will widen our vocabulary and focus on developing our predicting, sequencing, inferencing and retrieval skills.

Science

In Science this term, we will be finding out about different habitats. We'll explore the Arctic and Antarctic habitat and find out about life in the ocean or underground.

Music

We will explore music from the British Isles, learning some folk songs and creating music. We will compose music and evaluate our compositions.



PSHE

In PSHE, we will learn about citizenship. We will think about what makes a good school environment and community.

RE

We will think about what it means to belong to a faith community, considering how different faiths welcome people in different ceremonies and different occasions are celebrated.

Y1 Maths

Multiplication and division - grouping, arrays and doubles

Fractions - finding halves and quarters

Position and Direction - describe position and ordinal numbers

Place Value - number lines, partitioning into tens and ones, comparing numbers

Y2 Maths

Fractions - equal and unequal, half, quarter and third, find three quarters

Time - o'clock, half past, quarter to and past

Tell time to 5 minutes
