

English

This term we will be reading 'Mr Norton's New Hat', 'There's a Tiger in the Garden' and 'A Brave Bear'.



Year One children will be using these texts as a basis for their own writing including narratives, setting descriptions and fact files. Reception children will use Literacy time to embed their Phonics knowledge, practice early writing skills and handwriting.

PSHE

Our PSHE theme for this term is 'Building Relationships: My Family and Friends'. In these lessons, we will learn that we all have different beliefs and celebrations, what characteristics make a good friend, and how we need to listen to one another.



Music



Our Music theme this term is 'Transport'. We will learn to recognise that voices and instruments can imitate sounds from the world around us. We will learn that the beat is the steady pulse of a song and begin to recognise music that is 'fast' or 'slow'.

Art

In Art lessons this term, our theme is 'Woven Wonders'. We will be experimenting with wool wrapping, fiber art and the meaning of warp and weft.



RE

In Religious Education this term, our big question is, 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?' Within this unit, pupils will find out about the beliefs of Muslims, Christians and Jews. We will be discussing what it means to 'belong' and the communities that we are a part of.



Science

In Science we will be learning about Habitats from Around the World. We will use our 'Working Scientifically' skills to explore a range of different habitats and the impact that humans have on the natural world.

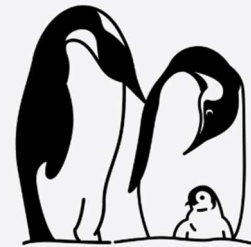
