History

We will be inspired by a local study and will help us understand some of the ways in which we find out about the past.

Science

In Science this term, we will identify a variety of plants and animals in their habitats and describe simple food chains. We will design a microhabitat where living things could survive. All this learning will take place in Forest School.

Music

We will be investigating musical structure by listening to, analysing and performing a song based on a well-known myth.

DT

We will explore various materials that can help us build structures. We will build a chair for a Baby Bear.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will learn about change as a normal part of life. We will think about moving to a new class.

RE

We will learn what Christians believe about the "good news" Jesus brings them. We will think about friendship and forgiveness.

PE

With Sports Day approaching, it is athletics season. We will be refining our throwing, catching, jumping and running skills.

Computing

We will be learning Data handling and creating an algorithm for growing a plant in space.

English

In English we'll be reading Pata's Pumpkin and Tidy.

We will:

- Write information text
- Write a book review
- Describe a setting
- Design an advert

In our whole class reading sessions, we will be reading both fiction and non-fiction books, along with some poetry. We will widen our vocabulary and focus on developing our predicting, sequencing, inferencing and retrieval skills.

Y1 Maths

Place Value - number lines, partitioning, comparing numbers

Money - unitising, recognising coins, counting in coins

Time - Days/months, hours/minutes/seconds, telling the time

Y2 Maths

Statistics - tally charts, tables, block diagrams, pictograms

Position and Direction - language of position, describing movement, shape patterns with turns
