Topic: Coasts

Maths:

We will be using the White Rose 'small steps' to cover the following topics during Summer 1:

Year 4:

Statistics, Position and Direction, Consolidation of learning

Year 5:

Negative numbers, Converting Units and Volume.

English:

Our focus text for Summer 1 is 'The Wreck of Zanzibar' by Michael Morpurgo.

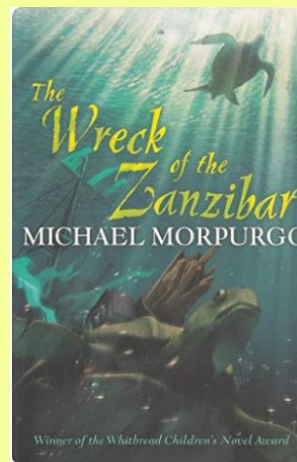
We will be looking at different writing outcomes over the term including character and setting descriptions, diary entries, poetry and more.

In WCR, we will be looking at a variety of examples of texts with cross curricular links. To support WCR, we will be using VIPERS to help deepen our understanding of the text and build reading skills with confidence.

DT:

We are going to be looking at cooking: developing a recipe.

In this unit, we will look existing products, following budgets, developing a recipe and evaluating a final product.



Geography:

This term, we are going to focus on Coasts. We are going to explore case studies in the UK and worldwide. We are going to explore physical and human features of coastlines, including tourism, settlements, economic activity and consider the impact of climate change, rising sea levels and pollution. This unit links well to our focus text this term.

Science:

In Science, we will be exploring teacher focus. This will comprise of previous units to revisit learning, including forces and magnets, plants and light. We will continue to support our learning through planned investigations. During this unit, we will continue to develop our scientific enquiry skills to support our scientific understanding of the world.

French:

In Summer 1, Juniper will be studying 'Les Romains' (Romans) in French. We will build on our existing knowledge of key vocabulary as well as introducing new vocabulary.

PSHE:

During Summer 2,, we will be learning about Citizenship, economic wellbeing, transitions into our next year group, and RSE.

Music:

In Summer 1, Juniper class will be preparing for KS2 summer production.

R.E:

We are going to be exploring the question - How and why do people mark significant events? We will explore baptism in Christianity, Hindu ceremonies to mark the journey of life, Jewish ceremonies to mark a child becoming an adult and marriage (religious and non-religious).

P.E:

During Summer 1, Juniper will participate in Cricket lessons, taught by both the class teacher and our specialist-led program ATLAS.

Computing:

In Summer 1, we will be exploring the role of data analysis with weather forecasting. We will have opportunity to design a weather station and present a weather forecast.
