



Willow Class Summer Term 2



English

In order to finish the Year 6 writing objectives, we will be reading and using The Nowhere Emporium by Ross MacKenzie as our class book. This mystical tale of magic and intrigue will allow us to remind ourselves of Y6 speech punctuation, write and act lots of dialogue and build up to writing our own narrative fiction magical mystery story before the end of June. We will continue to read the book until the end of term when we will answer the question that we posed – is the Nowhere Emporium better than Harry Potter?

Separately, we will continue to work on our Y6 production where we will work on learning our lines, hone our acting skills and learn to how to listen and respond to each other.

Maths

Whilst the Y6 curriculum has been completed, we will continue to work on our Maths reasoning and problem-solving skills. We will look at different Maths related activities and use all of our Maths knowledge to try and solve them. We will also continue to practise our mental maths skills.

RE

'How does faith help people when life gets hard? Why do some people believe in God and some not? are the questions we will be trying to solve this term. We will consider what is meant by suffering, as well as think about what makes us happy. We will then think about how faith can guide people through difficult times and consider life after death from both the religious and non-religious perspective.

Geography

This term we will be thinking about how our world may look in the future.

We will study and map the area of Woodchester near our school. We will consider both the physical and human aspects of the village and consider how it could look, whether it has the amenities to support itself and whether there are any changes that would be needed to future proof Woodchester village.

PSHE

This term, we will cover a mixture of topics. We will look at the importance of identity and positive body image before moving on to look at transition and moving from primary to secondary school.

We will also be learning about our changing bodies, naming the body parts correctly and learn about conception and birth using the Kapow scheme, specially designed for primary schools.(A separate letter with further information about this will be sent out nearer the time)

Science

We will be celebrating all things Science during June as we enjoy Woodchester Science week in the first week back. This year, the theme of our week is 'British Wildlife' and so we will carry out an investigation linked to this. We will also be researching bats.

We will also continue with our 'Humans and other animals' topic.

DesignTechnology

We will be designing and building playground structures in miniature. We will consider what makes a good structure, measure carefully and evaluate our designs.

PE

On Thursdays we will be looking at our athletic skills in preparation for school sports day. On Tuesdays we will be focussing on our musicality during dance lessons and play rehearsals.

Music

We will spend time rehearsing for the production, as well as the leavers' services.

Computing

We will learn how to design an electronic product and then consider which programming language is best to achieve our outcomes. We will use our previous learning as building blocks to sequence, select, repeat and build coding.

French

In this unit pupils will learn about other countries around the globe that speak French. They will also learn about the currencies, flags, cultural celebrations and traditions of those countries
