

Loss of nesting trees and bamboo have caused red pandas to decline because their homes have been destroyed.

Red pandas are losing their homes to livestock herding.

Livestock herding is driving red pandas to extinction. Hu have been harvesting bamboo, gathering firewood and collecting medicinal herb.

Population

It is estimated that there are less than 10,000 and as few as 2,500 red pandas remaining in the wild.



Pollution

When coal is burned and released into air, it deposits onto bamboo leaves meaning they will eat them and are at risk of it passing to their offspring.

Overconsumption

Red pandas are killed for food, medicine, pet trade and their distinctive red fur.
